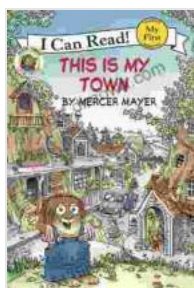


This Is My Town: A First Can Read Book Review

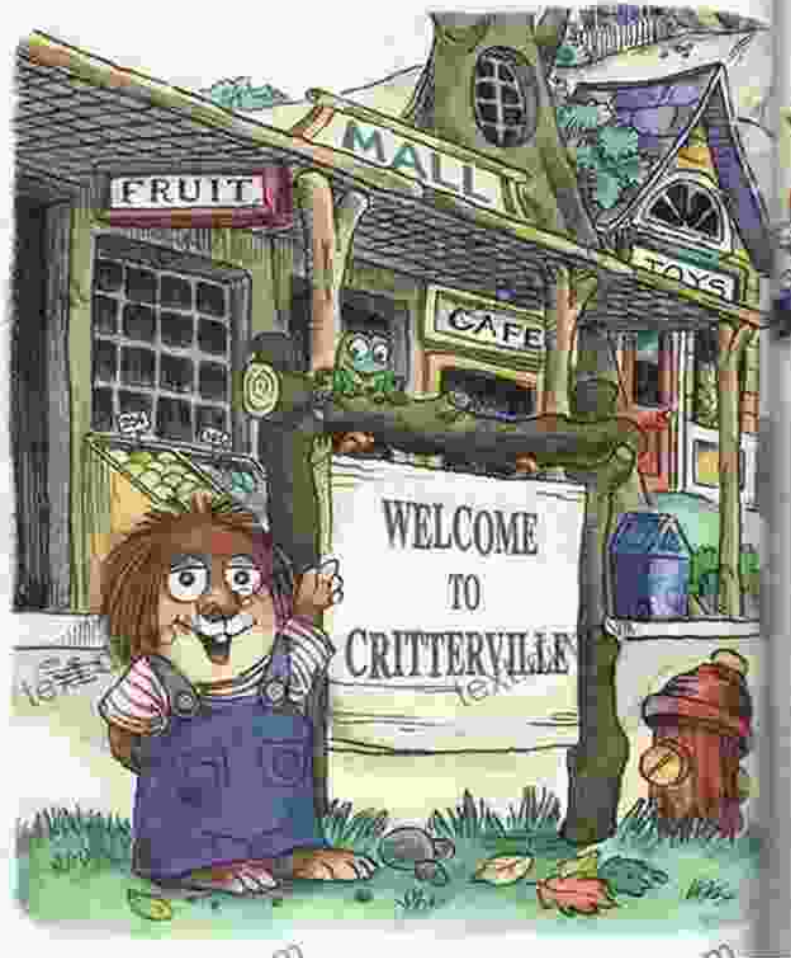
What I Don't Like About This Is My Town

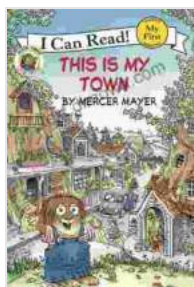


About the Author

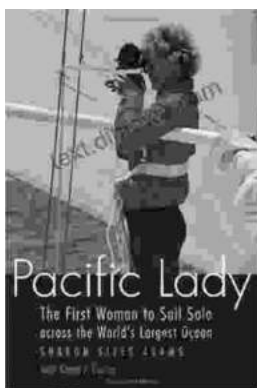

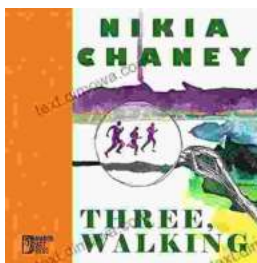
